

TUITION INCENTIVE PROGRAMS



\$5,000 Tuition Rebate for Referring a New Student

The more quality students we have the better off we will be, from a cost of tuition to program perspective. We believe that parental word of mouth is our greatest resource for admissions. So, if you refer a student to WFS, and the student is deemed a good fit and is enrolled, you will receive a tuition rebate up to \$5,000 spread out over four years and payable in May of each enrolled year (Year 1: \$500, Year 2: \$1500, Year 3: \$1500, Year 4: \$1500). Please note that in order to receive the rebate each May, you must have at least one child enrolled at WFS and the student you referred must also remain enrolled. \$500 Tuition Discount for Referring an 8th Grader

If you refer an eighth grade student who is admitted and enrolled, you will receive a \$500 tuition rebate as long as at least one of your children is enrolled at WFS.



Sibling Discount

We recognize the sacrifices families make to send their children to Westfield Friends School. As such, we believe it is important to ease the financial burden for families with multiple students enrolled. Beginning in this new contract season, families with more than one child enrolled in the same academic year will receive a 5% tuition discount for each younger sibling of the oldest child enrolled.

Tuition Freeze for Middle School Years

Beginning in the new contract season, the tuition you pay for Middle School in 2017-18 will remain the tuition you will pay until your child graduates. For classes coming into the Middle School in subsequent years, the tuition set for sixth grade, at that time, will remain the tuition those families will pay until those students graduate. Families will still be eligible for the Sibling Discount, should it apply.



Two Year Financial Aid Awards

We are aware that it can be cumbersome to complete all of the necessary paperwork that comes with applying for financial aid. There is also uncertainty in a family's year to year budgeting, particularly when it is not clear what dollar amount may be awarded. For those reasons, beginning in this new contract season, the amount of your financial aid award will be the same for two consecutive years, and there will be no need to re-apply at the beginning of year two of that award cycle. This means a lot less work for you, and creates a situation where you can forecast your award for a full year more than the current system allows.
